CONCENTRATION OPTIONS: 12 Upper Level Sem./Hrs. OR 24 Sem./Hrs. at any Level

A concentration is defined as a grouping of courses in a particular discipline. The Faculty of EC has voted to allow two definitions of the word “concentration”:

(1) a choice of 12 semester hours at the upper level (junior/senior courses) or

(2) a choice of taking 24 semester hours in a particular discipline by combining freshmen-senior level courses. (For example: The 24 hours can be from a grouping of courses in a particular discipline that can be earned at a community college through an A.S. program and transferred in to Ecclesia.)
